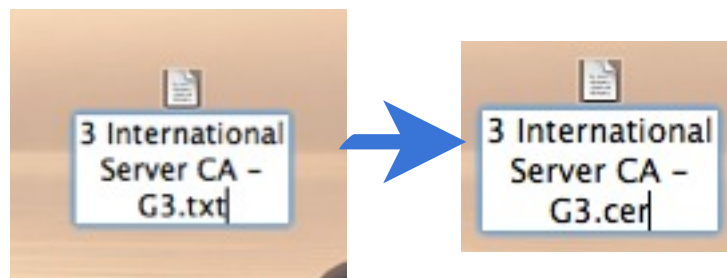


# How to Import a Certificate Into a Mac

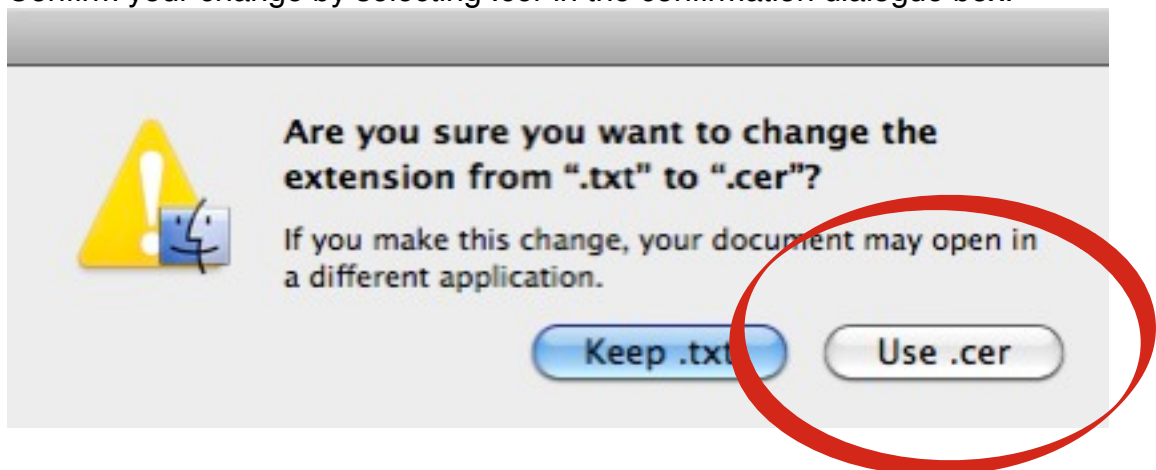
- I. If downloading the certificate from email, the file will have been renamed to a .txt file type so that it can get through Outlook. If loading from USB or other media, please skip to Number II.
  - A. Place the certificate on the desktop of the Mac.



- B. Rename the file from .txt to .cer



- C. Confirm your change by selecting .cer in the confirmation dialogue box.



- II. Double click on the “*VeriSign Class 3 International Server CA - G3*” file. You will be prompted to authenticate to import the certificate. Enter user name and password with a user who has administrative privileges on the Mac (This will typically be the user account).



- III. Verify that the certificate was imported.
  - A. In the top right of the screen, click on the finder (Magnifying glass) and type in Keychain and select “*Keychain Access*”



- B. In the Keychain Access screen, Ensure that you are in the System Keychain and Certificates Category. Verify that you do see the “VeriSign Class 3 International Server CA - G3” certificate listed. If you see that certificate listed, launch Safari and attempt to connect to [citrix.swedishamerican.org](http://citrix.swedishamerican.org) and verify that an application will properly launch.
